

Directions from the M3 Blue Route

- 1 So you are cruising toward Cape Town on the M3 Blue Route (a.k.a the Simon van de Stel Freeway). Heads up because there is a fixed speed camera underneath the Ladies Mile turnoff bridge. The Max speed is 100km/h.
- 2 Just carry on traveling along the M3 as its name changes to Edinburgh Drive (suburb: Bishops Court), then Union Avenue, and then Rhodes Drive (you'll have UCT Upper Campus on your left).
- 3 Soon after UCT comes hospital bend. Alright, stay in the left lane 'cause you need to take the left fork this time onto De Waal Drive (M3), Cape Town's most enjoyable road to drive.
- 4 Enjoy the twists and turns but at the end, under the walkover bridge, beware of the fixed speed trap on the left. The max speed is only 60km/h. Soon after this camera, you must take the sweeping left off ramp (marked for directions to the Table Mountain Cablecar).
- 5 Follow this road as its name changes from Jutland to Mill to Annandale to Orange. Pass the Mount Nelson 5 star hotel on your left until ...
- 6 ...eventually you get to the intersection between Orange, Buitensingel, Long and Kloof. "Long Street Baths" should be on your right.
- 7 Carry on straight up Buitensingel and turn right into Bree Street.
- 8 Travel about 4 or 5 blocks keeping an eye out to your right and voilà! you'll see the big black THULE sign above the entrance to the Load & Go store and drive-in fitment centre on the other side of the road.
